

# I am not running away from Pakistan: Pervez Musharraf

Islamabad, Aug 10: Amid reports that the Pakistan government was under pressure to allow Pervez Musharraf to leave the country, the former military ruler today said he will not flee and defend himself in all cases.

"I am not running away from Pakistan. Rather, I will defend myself in all cases before any court of law," the 70-year-old said in a telephonic address to a small gathering of supporters at a convention of his All Pakistan Muslim League (APML) party here. He, however explained that he needed to go to see his ailing mother in Dubai but will return back.

The government has so far refused to allow him to travel abroad. In his address, Musharraf termed all cases against him as politically motivated and baseless. He also criticised the government for the economic mismanagement and said when he resigned in 2008, the country had USD 18 billion reserves as compared to only USD 4 billion to USD 5 billion today. His remarks came hours after a close associate of Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif said the government is under pressure to let Musharraf leave the country. "There is pressure on the government to allow General Musharraf to leave Pakistan," Raja Zafarul Haq, Leader of the House in Senate, told the media in Rawalpindi.

Haq, who is a senior leader of Sharif's Pakistan Muslim

League-Nawaz (PML-N), told Express News television that the government was under pressure on the issue but did not name the forces or individuals applying that pressure. Analysts have said the powerful military is not happy with the treason case against Musharraf.

A three-member tribunal is trying the former military ruler for imposing emergency in the country in 2007 which is considered as a treason under the Constitution and is punishable with death or life term imprisonment.

Haq claimed the anti-government agitation by controversial cleric Tahirul Qadri and the planned protests by Imran Khan on Thursday was a "drama" being staged to get Musharraf released. "Hidden forces which didn't want legal action against Musharraf and wanted a safe exit for him are pressuring the premier," the PML-N leader said.

Musharraf was charged on March 31 for subverting the constitution by imposing emergency. In June, Pakistan's Supreme Court overturned a High Court ruling to lift a travel ban slapped on Musharraf last year.

Musharraf, who returned to Pakistan in March last year ahead of the general elections ending his over four-year self-imposed exile, has faced multiple trials including the one under the high-treason act for which he was placed under house arrest and barred from travelling abroad.

# Palestinians accept new 72-hour ceasefire offer

Gaza/Jerusalem, Aug 10: Bloodbath in Gaza continued unabated today with Israeli jets pounding the coastal strip, even as the fragile peace process got a new lease of life with Palestinian negotiators saying they have accepted an Egyptian proposal for a new 72-hour truce with Israel.

"We are here to look for an agreement. We cannot have an agreement without talks, so we accepted an Egyptian proposal to have a ceasefire for 72 hours in order to resume the talks," a Palestinian negotiator said.

The decision was confirmed by other Palestinian negotiators as well, Al Arabiya

reported. It was not yet known as to when the ceasefire would come into effect as there was no response from the Israeli side. The Palestinian decision came after Israel said it was prepared for a protracted military action in Gaza and would not return to Egyptian-mediated "negotiations under fire". The Palestinian decision could pave the way for renewed negotiations with Israel on a long-term durable truce in the Gaza Strip.

Earlier, Palestinian negotiators said they would leave if Israel did not attend without preconditions. "If the Israelis do not come, we will leave to consult with our leadership," said Izzat Al-Risheq, a member of the Palestinian negotiation team. "We gave

our demands to the Egyptian delegation seven days ago. We have not yet received any official response yet." Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu today said Israel will not return to talks while Palestinian militants continue cross-border rocket attacks. "Israel will not engage in negotiations under fire, and will continue to act in every way to change the current reality and to bring quiet to all of its citizens," he told a cabinet meeting at the defence ministry in Tel Aviv.

Meanwhile, hostilities have continued unabated since the collapse of the three-day truce on Friday with the Israeli military hitting 150 targets, killing 15 people, and

Palestinian militants firing more than 100 rockets into Israel. The Israeli air force struck at least 20 targets in Gaza overnight. There was no let up in violence with a 17-year-old boy killed in an Israeli strike on central Gaza, medics said. Tensions have also been growing in the West Bank where protesters clashed with Israeli troops. A 11-year-old Palestinian boy was shot dead by Israeli troops in a refugee camp in the southern West Bank today.

Over a month of bloody fighting has killed more than 2,000 Palestinians and 67 in Israel, most of them soldiers. About 10,000 people have been injured in the conflict.

# Iran airliner crashes, at least 38 dead

Tehran, Aug 10: An Iranian passenger plane crashed today moments after takeoff from Tehran, killing at least 38 on board and narrowly avoiding many more deaths when it plummeted near a busy market.

The plane was headed to the eastern city of Tabas, the IRNA and Fars news agencies said, when it crashed at 9.18 am local time, after leaving Mehrabad airport.

It triggered a fireball when it smashed into the capital's Azadi neighbourhood, close to where hundreds of military families live, and only a few hundred metres (yards) from a row of shops. Iran's deputy transport minister, Ahmad Majidi, said the Antonov An-140 turboprop plane had 40 passengers, including six children, and eight crew on board, and he put the death toll at 38.

A fire official initially

said all on board had been killed but Fars later reported that 37 bodies were sent to the morgue and IRNA said nine people were hospitalised, two of them critically injured.

The aircraft was operated by Sepahan Airlines and a tailfin bearing the company's dolphin logo could be seen sticking out of the road as security forces cordoned off the crash site where firefighters had doused the flames. Black smoke billowed from the mass of burnt twisted metal, with officials saying the plane hit a wall and trees.

Mehrabad airport is near central Tehran and it is by far the country's busiest domestic hub, serving routes to all major Iranian cities. Most international passenger flights take off from Tehran's Imam Khomeini International Airport, which is located further west of the capital. AFP

# Israel hopes India's UN vote decision would not impact ties

New Delhi, Aug 10: Days after India voted against it at the UN, Israel today hoped the Indian decision would not impact on the robust Indo-Israel ties in strategic areas of defence and security, to which they have added some more "ingredients" in the past few months.

Noting that Israel was in touch with Indian government at various levels "before, during and after the voting" on the UN Human Rights Council resolution to launch a probe into Israel's offensive on Gaza, newly-appointed Israeli Ambassador Daniel Carmon says his country would appreciate better understanding among its international interlocutors on its role in the current Gaza conflict.

However, Carmon, who assumed charge 10 days back, did not comment on whether he conveyed Israel's disappointment to Indian interlocutors after New Delhi voted against Jerusalem and said, "We have expressed to all our interlocutors including in India, how we feel about the conflict, sources of the conflict...And we will continue doing so."

Criticising the United Nations for allegedly indulging in "Israel-bashing", the Israeli Ambassador told PTI in an interview that "I don't like the voting and resolution,

For many years what is going on in the UN is very much politicised....We did not like the result of international community (voting) on the resolution. We have the mission to make our interlocutors understand (our stand)..."

"We expect the support and understanding of our friends and interlocutors all over the world to the need of Israel to safeguard (its interest)."

India joined Brazil, Russia, China and South Africa to vote for a Palestinian-drafted resolution on "Ensuring Respect for international law in the Occupied Palestinian Territories, including East Jerusalem". In the 47-member council, 29 countries voted in sup-

port of the resolution while 17 nations abstained. The US was the only nation to vote against the resolution. The European Union-bloc also abstained.
