

Ikhwani turned Army man shot dead

Kulgam, July 16: Suspected militants Wednesday shot dead a soldier in Khudwani area of this south Kashmir district, police said. "Gowhar Ahmad Matoon of Bashir Ahmad Matoon of Ganjipora village in Khudwani area, working with Territorial Army (TA) was shot at by unknown militants from point blank range when he was returning home from the market," a police official said.

He said Gowhar was hit by a pistol bullet in his head and died on the spot. "The incident took place at around 4:15 p.m. in the busy Khudwani-Qaimoh market and the assailants, after carrying out the attack, managed to flee from the spot," the police official said.

He said the deceased trooper was posted in Sector-2 of 62 RR and had come home on leave.

Gowhar was working as government gunman

(Ikhwani) before he was inducted into Territorial Army.

Locals said soon after the incident, Police, Army and CRPF laid cordon and launched search to nab the assailants.

No militant outfit has so far claimed responsibility for the attack when this report was filed.

Superintendent of Police (SP) Kulgam, Mumtaz Ahmad, while confirming the incident, said they are investigating the matter.

PDP leader attacked in Pulwama

Pulwama, July 16: Unidentified persons attacked Peoples Democratic Party leader Ghulam Mohiuddin Wachi with some explosive device in here Wednesday afternoon. However no one was hurt in the incident.

According to reports, some unknown persons lobbed the explosive device at the vehicle, carrying PDP district president near Batpora Nyaina at around 3.40 p.m. However no one was hurt in the attack.

Soon after the incident, police and paramilitary CRPF sealed the area and search operations were

started to nab the attackers.

Meanwhile, slamming assault on its leader and candidate from Noorabad assembly segment, Abdul Majid Padder, near Qaimoh in south Kashmir's Kulgam district yesterday evening, PDP today said it was deliberately done to instil fear among the people before Assembly elections.

"Such attacks are carried out with a special design to create fear on the ground and silence the people keeping in view the ensuing assembly elections," a party spokesman said in a statement.

Engine failure halts Delhi-Katra train for 2 hours

Katra, July 16: Barely a day after its first run, the New Delhi-Katra Shri Shakti express was stuck inside a tunnel on Katra-Udhampur track for about two hours, just 5 kms before Katra Railway Station, reportedly due to the engine failure.

According to sources, fully air conditioned train 22461 on its second run came to a standstill due to some technical snag developed in the engine in Tunnel 27.

"The halt inside the tunnel just 5 kms before its destination delayed the train by 2 hours and arrived at Katra at 7 a.m. against the scheduled arrival time of 5.10

a.m." officials at Katra Railway Station told Greater Kashmir.

While unconfirmed sources said the train was suspended due to failure of the engine, Northern Railway PRO, Manish Tiwari told Greater Kashmir that it was stopped because the wheels of train turned slippery due to excess water on the track. He said that there was no problem with track or engine.

He added as there are all the facilities available on the track, the driver immediately contacted the control room. "On the directions of control room, a banker engine was pushed in services from Udhampur Railway station," sources said.

10,613 Yatris pay obeisance

Srinagar, July 16: 10,613 devotees paid obeisance before at the Cave shrine today. With this, a total of 2,54,935 pilgrims have paid obeisance at the Holy Cave since the commencement of Amarnath Yatra this year.

Army rescues accident victim

Srinagar, July 16: The Army's local RR unit at Nutnussa rescued one car accident victim of Choghul village, who lost control over the vehicle which fell into a canal while returning home from Kupwara yesterday.

According to a defence spokesman, the Army unit located nearby immediately reacted and rescued the victim Azhar Ganai.

"The victim was provided medical aid and the car handed over to him. His family expressed their gratitude to Army for its support and assistance," said the spokesman.

Bubhar Pulwama sans power, water

Srinagar, July 16: Inhabitants of Bubhar in South Kashmir's Pulwama district Wednesday said their locality was reeling under darkness for last ten days besides facing scarcity of drinking water in the Holy month of Ramadhan.

A delegation from the locality said officials have failed to pay heed to their repeated pleas for restoration of power.

"The transformer in our locality developed some snag ten days ago and was sent for repairing. The locality reels under darkness since then as it

was not brought back quickly as was promised," they said.

They said that they had approached PDD higher ups but to no avail. "We are facing immense hardships especially during Sehri and Iftaar timings without electricity," they added.

They said the local water supply plant also has become defunct, resulting in scarcity of water to the local population.

They threatened to hit streets in case power is not restored to the locality forthwith.

Hakim Yasin for release of prisoners

SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT TO THE TIME SCALE OF THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE (KAS) BY SELECTION FROM TECHNICAL SERVICES.

In terms of the Rule 6(c) of the Jammu and Kashmir Administrative Service Rules, the recruitment to the service has to be made in the following manner:

- by a competitive examination to the junior scale posts of the service;
- by promotion to the time scale of the service from amongst the members of the 18 departmental feeding services holding pay scale of Rs. 7500-12000 (pre-revised) now revised to Rs. 9300-34800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4800 or any other higher grade in that service;
- by selection to the time scale of service from amongst the persons of exceptional ability and merit serving in connection with the affairs of the State in departments/ services other than those covered under clause (b) carrying pay scale equivalent, to, or higher than, the time scale of Jammu and Kashmir Administrative Service, on the recommendations of the concerned administrative departments;

Provided that only such persons shall be eligible for consideration who have not attained the age of 54 years on 1st January of the year in which the recommendation in this behalf is sought by the General Administration Department.

As per the extant rules, 10% of the vacancies are allocable to the category of the officers falling within the purview of Rule 6(c) of the KAS Rules, 2008, who should:

- be of exceptional merit and ability;
- be holding pay scale equivalent to, or higher than, the Time Scale of Jammu and Kashmir Administrative Service;
- not have attained the age of 54 years as on 1st January of the year in which the recommendation in this behalf is sought by the General Administration Department.
- be duly recommended by the concerned Administrative Department.

22 slots, as per the following category wise break-up, have become available on 1.1.2014, which are to be filled up through appointment by selection from amongst the officers referred to in Rule

6(c) of KAS Rules, 2008:


