

PDP announces 4TH list of candidates

Constitutes manifesto committee

Srinagar, July 21: Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) today constituted a manifesto committee and announced the fourth list of candidates for the ensuing elections to the Assembly.

This decision was taken at the meeting of party's Political Affairs Committee (PAC) held under the chairmanship of Mufti Muhammad Sayeed.

The members of the committee are: Muzaffar Husain Baig, Tariq Hameed Kara, S Rangeel Singh, Haseeb Drabu, Rafeeq Husain Khan, A R Veeri, Naem Akhtar, Zaffar Manhas and Firdous Tak.

The committee has been tasked to prepare a draft manifesto for the party for approval after consultations.

The party announced the list of candidates for four more constituencies.

From Handwara constituency, Ghulam Mohi-u-din Sofi has been given party mandate; from Vijaypur Dr Harmesh Salathia; from Jammu West Daman Bhasin and from Mahore the party has nominated Shafiq-u-Rehman.

Ex - Cong MP resigns

Jammu, July 21: Alleging 'back stabbing' by the party leadership, two time Congress Member Parliament from Udhampur-Doda constituency, Chaudhary Lal Singh today resigned from the party and ended years long association with the party.

Addressing a press conference here today, Chaudhary Lal Singh said the state Congress party and particularly leader of opposition in Rajya Sabha Ghulam Nabi Azad had betrayed him.

"I worked for Congress party for 24 hours with full dedication and zeal but party ditched me to satisfy the desires of some power hungry people," Lal Singh fumed.

He said that party had promised him ticket from

Udhampur-Doda-Kathua constituency, but it fielded Ghulam Nabi Azad by overlooking his past track record.

"The party move was aimed at to appease some self centric leaders," Lal Singh alleged.

Responding to queries of any possibility to rejoin Congress party in future, Lal Singh quipped that if Party declares him Chief Ministerial candidate for J&K assembly polls, he would definitely lead the party to win 30 plus seats.

Pertinently, Lal Singh's association with Congress started as a student leader. He won Assembly elections in 2002 and was health minister in PDP-Congress regime. Lal Singh got mandate for Udhampur-Doda Parliamentary seat, which he won for two consecutive terms.

Tramboo pays tributes to Suhail

Srinagar, July 21: Paying tributes to Suhail Ahmad Lone, who was killed in Kulgam yesterday, Chief patron JKLF-R, Barrister Abdul Majeed Tramboo said such actions were aimed to prove that 'India does in Kashmir what Israel is doing in Palestine.'

"As Israel is killing the Palestinians, in Kashmir, India is killing those who stand up in favour of Palestinians. On every front India is trying its best to

muzzle the just and genuine voices," Tramboo said in a statement issued here.

He also condemned the use of force by the state Police and the Central Reserve Police Force, on the peaceful anti-Israeli demonstrations in Kashmir.

Meanwhile, JKLF-R chairman Farooq Ahmad Dar (Bitta Karatey) attended the Iftar party organized by the Pakistani High Commission, New-Delhi.

Vakil hails party decision on NC

Srinagar, July 21: Lauding the decision of the party high command for going all alone in the forthcoming Assembly elections, JKPC senior vice president and former Minister, Abdul Gani Vakil Monday said it will help the party to get back its lost credibility and honour.

In a statement, Vakil said that though it was the prerogative of the high command either to accord sanc-

tion to the poll alliance or to fight the elections all alone, but it has prioritized and respected the aspirations of the rank and file of the party.

"Congress has never fought elections with a single motive to grab power but has aimed to strengthen the democratic system of the country and ensure larger participation of the people," Vakil added.

Subject: Tie up of Group Janta Personal Accidental Insurance Policy with M/S Oriental Insurance Company Ltd for 3 years (2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17) commencing from 17th July 2014 and deduction of premium thereof on annual basis.

- The State Government has Laid up the Group Janta Personal Accidental Insurance Policy with M/S Oriental Insurance Company Ltd for three years (2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17) commencing from 17th July 2014 (midnight) on annual renewal basis for securing a policy for its employees to cover accidental deaths and disabilities under the said scheme. The arrangement involves annual premium of Rs. 125/- (Rupees one hundred twenty five only) plus State Taxes at the rate of Rs. 13/- per employee. The policy shall cover an aggregate of 3.40 lac employees of all categories working in the State Government Departments/PSUs/Autonomous Bodies (including Local Bodies/Universities) and shall include the Daily Rated Workers, Consolidated/ Contractual /Adhoc Employees and the SPOs.
- The policy is on compulsory basis for all above categories of employees and shall secure them against accidental deaths and disabilities partial or full.
- An Insurance cover of Rs. 5 lac (Rupees five lac only) will be available from M/S Oriental insurance Company to the Nominee(s) / Legal Heir(s) of an employee who is covered under this arrangement and dies in course of an accident. Similarly, the cover is available to an employee for any total or partial disability suffered in an accident / during the period of the scheme. For partial disabilities, the Insurance cover varies as per the percentage of disability as per the MOU.
- Deduction: All the DDOs shall deduct an amount of Rs. 138 (Rupees one hundred thirty eight only) on account of annual premium from the salaries of the Employees for the month of July, 2014 payable in August, 2014 and remit the same into the Government Treasuries under the following Heads of Account:

M.H:8235-General and Other Reserve Funds	Rs.125/ (Rupees one hundred twenty five only)
M.H:0040 Taxes on Sales, Trade etc. Minor Head: 800 - Other Receipts.	Rs.13/- (Rupees thirteen only) @10.5%

- Similarly, the DDO of State PSUs, Autonomous Bodies, Local Bodies and Universities shall remit the amount of 138/- (Rupees one hundred thirty eight only) in respect of their employees for being covered under the scheme through separate demand drafts (one for Rs. 125/- and another for Rs. 13/-) favouring Joint Director Resources/Chief Accounts Officer, Finance Department on or before 5th August 2014 positively.
- All DDOs of Government Departments shall thereafter furnish the details of employees in respect of whom the premium amount has been deducted and remitted to the Government Account to their concerned Treasury Officers who shall forward the same to Director General, Accounts & Treasuries within 10 days. The Director General Accounts & Treasuries shall consolidate the information (DDO-wise) and forward the same to the Special Secretary (Nodal Officer), Finance Department on most immediate basis.
- Since the policy is compulsory in nature, it shall be personal responsibility and liability of the DDOs/ HODs/ Managing Directors/ Chief Executive Officers/ Registrar of Universities to register every employee under the scheme so that no employee is left out. The Nodal Officer shall not accept any intimation of an accidental death or disability of any employee for processing insurance payments under this scheme unless the concerned DDO will certify that the premium amount has been deducted from the concerned employee in time.
- Employees covered under the scheme are required to fill up a Nomination Form as already prescribed giving all the relevant details of their nominee(s) so that the insurance payments are made to such nominee(s) only in the case of accidental death by concerned DDOs. The Nomination Forms shall be retained by the DDOs concerned and kept in their safe custody for reference and records as and when need arises. It should be noted that filling of Nomination Form after the death of any employee is strictly prohibited and against the ethics and norms.

- To ensure speedy settlement of insurance claims, intimations of accidental deaths or partial/permanent disabilities should be promptly sent to the Nodal Officer in Finance Department directly by the concerned DDO not later than 45 days from the date of accident along with two attested copies of below mentioned documents:

- FIR/Police Final Report.
- Death Certificate
- Post Mortem Report.
- Disability certificate (in case of disablement) indicating the permanent nature of disablement with percentage. (Note: the disablement certificate should not be conditional).
- Nomination Form.
- Premium Deduction Certificate to be issued by concerned DDO carrying reference of Treasury Voucher No. and date of remittance of premium.
- It shall be the responsibility of the DDO to:
 - Check and satisfy himself/herself about the genuineness of an accidental claim. Any deviation will be the personal responsibility of the DDO and so the consequences arising out of such deviation. This may please be noted.
 - DDO are strictly advised against:
 - Intimation should only be serviced through Registered Post/ Speed Post with acknowledgement due or through a messenger against proper receipt. No responsibility will be cast on the Nodal Officer if any intimation sent by any other means gets lost in transit.
 - Sending intimations to the Nodal Officer beyond the prescribed time period.
