Dir CAPD reviews stock position

Srinagar, July 22: Director, Consumer Affairs and Public Distribution Department (CAPD), Kashmir, Bilal Ahmad Bhat today reviewed the stock position of essential commodities including rice, atta, sugar, k-oil and LPG cylinders at a meeting here. Among others, Joint Director CAPD Kashmir, Deputy Director Supplies, Deputy Director CAPD South Kashmir besides representatives of various Oil Companies attended the meeting. It was given out in the meeting that adequate stocks of essentials besides k-oil and LPG cylinders are available in the Valley. The meeting was informed that 32,527 metric tons of rice, 3573 metric tons of sugar have been already despatched to the different sale outlets of the Valley including the remote destinations of Gurez, Tulail, Karnah, Uri and Machil. Besides, 45541 metric tons of rice, 2270 metric tons of sugar and 19122 metric tons of atta are available with the departmental godowns in the Valley, an official statement said.

KEA-D comes in open against Khan-led Kashmir Economic Alliance

Says senior office bearers of KEA-K paving way for BJP to win elections in Kashmir

Srinagar, July 22: In an open attack against Kashmir Economic Alliance led by Muhammad Yaseen Khan and its office bearers, the breakaway KEA led by Farooq Ahmad Dar today accused the former of having been in 'tactical understanding' with Bharat Janata Party (BJP) candidates to pave way for them to win elections in Kashmir. Adhoc, chairman, KEA, Farooq Dar alleged that "Khan and his supporters Siraj Ahmad and Iqbal Trumboo in the past held many deliberations with centre government agencies and for that

they travelled to New Delhi many times." "They are working to fulfill the aim of BJP to win 6 seats from Kashmir," Dar said, adding that the disgruntled elements want to cash on the "popularity" of the alliance in Kashmir to serve their "personal ends". Dar alleged: "In past Yasin Khan, Siraj Ahmad and Iqbal Tramboo were pitching for turning the alliance into a political party but we resisted such moves." President, Kashmir Hotels and Restaurant Association (KHARA), Showkat Chowdhary said the rally which was earlier held by

KEA where elected representatives participated "gives clear idea where Khan and his other colleagues were heading for." "Before the congregation of Panch and Sarpanchs, Iqbal Tramboo had a detailed meeting with senior Congress leader Jairam Ramesh at his hotel," he alleged. "Ahead of the rally, we were told that Panchs and Sarpanchs would resign and join the alliance, but we were shocked when there was no such announcement made by the elected representatives," said Chowdhary. Chowdhary said the former office bearers of KEA used alli-

ance for their personal interests. "They blackmailed JK Bank in order to get their loans waived," he alleged. To mention the Kashmir Economic Alliance - an amalgam of various traders bodies have developed cracks after the group led by Muhammad Yaseen Khan organized a rally of Sarpanchs and Panchs here. Chief spokesperson, KEA - D, M Y Chapri said: "The ad hoc body will work hard to live up to the expectations of the business community and has also already drafted the constitution." He said: "We have already announced the election schedule

and election will be held in transparent manner." Pertinently, Khan had earlier said KEA led by him is an apolitical organizing and Panchs and Sarpanchs are neither its members nor associated to it.

Karra reviews facilities at Srinagar airport

Airline Operators' Association pitch for night landing, direct flights to Gulf

Srinagar, July 22: A foremost association of airline operators Tuesday pitched for a complete renovation of services at Srinagar International Airport and sought renaming of the aerodrome as Sheik-ul-Alam International Airport Srinagar. It also sought night landing facility at the airport, a long-pending demand of

stakeholders. The association, Airline Operators Association, in a high-level meeting with Member Parliament and Chairman of Advisory Committee Tariq Hameed Karra sought up-gradation of the entire airport. In the meeting, the association gave various suggestions, foremost among them night landing system and direct international flights to Gulf countries. The association, represented by its head Khurshed Ahmad, proposed that gates of the airport be made friendlier by installing screener machines for baggage screening "or else additional x-ray machines be provided for quick and smooth flow of passengers." "[Also] more gates to be opened in

the terminal building while entering for check-in formalities preferably dedicated to individual airlines," the association proposed, adding that additional gates be opened for simultaneous boarding. "Washrooms should be increased in arrival/departure (security area)." The association also proposed for modification of public address system "as the existing system is not audible." "Cargo house should also be made available with sufficient x-rays, cold storage facilities and custom clearing officer." It also sought installation of runway lights and approach lights as per ICAO standard and extension of check-in counters towards Hajj departure "as proposed earlier for facilitation of senior citizens/expectant

mothers/incapacitated passengers." The association also picked holes in heating and air-conditioning of the entire aerodrome, saying it was "insufficient." "Improvement should also be made in restaurants and cafeterias," the association demanded, adding that foreign registration forms should be for arrival and departure. It also sought establishment of a waiting hall for passengers and more aerobridges in the terminal building. The meeting was attended by K S Rao, Airport Director; Manzoor Dalal, SSP Srinagar Airport; Khurshid Ahmad from Jet Airways; Muhammad Iqbal from Air India; Sartaj Ahmad Mantoo from Spice Jet; Amir Miraj from Go Airlines; Aliya Bashir of Indigo and Prashant, Commandant CRPF.
