# Growing culture of Iftar parties brings business to restaurants in Kashmir

Srinagar, July 25: The holy month of Ramadhan may be ordinarily a lean period for them, but the growing culture of hosting Iftar parties at restaurants has brought some good business to Valley-based restaurateurs. The Iftar bookings in restaurants and food outlets during the last week of Ramadhan have fairly increased, the restaurateurs said. Addition of some new

dishes from Pakistan and Middle East countries to the Ramadhan menu has found many takers in Kashmir, the restaurateurs said. For food lovers the dishes like Mughlai chicken, yogurt, fruit chaat, Falsa sharbat from Pakistan and chicken madrouba from Middle East are some of the special Ramadhan additions teasing the taste buds of foodies here. Managing Director, Hat-

trick Group, Babar Chowdhary said that during last few years the culture of Iftar parties has increased in Kashmir. "Apart from the high profile official or political Iftar parties, the common people especially the youth have also begun to prefer to break the fast with friends in restaurants. Last year we witnessed a good business in Ramadhan so this year we had decided to include some of the fresh recipes to satisfy the taste buds of our custom-



ers," he said. "In order to meet their requirements, restaurants and food outlets in Kashmir have come up with special menus and packages for people hosting Iftar parties," he said. Managing Director, 7 C's Café and Fine Dine, Sheikh Feroz said hosting of Iftar parties has become a new craze among Valleyites. "Not only people invite friends but many of them come along with families to relish dinners at

restaurants," he said. "At 7 C's we have introduced special Iftar cuisines in the pattern of middle east style. The response has been good and people are now coming out in good numbers to host or attend Iftar parties which is a good sign for the hospitality sector in Kashmir." Local hotels, restaurants and food chains attract the general public with "family deals" that combine both the food and the ambience for cel-

ebrating Iftar parties. While outdoor Iftaar gathering is mostly found popular in Pakistan and other Muslim countries, the locals here too have imbibed the trend. In Kashmir the trend is believed to have been introduced by the business fraternity and political parties who during this month invite people to Iftar parties. Many business organization here have also introduced the open air Iftaar gathering in the valley.

## 'CM assures revival of sick units'

FCIK delegation calls on Omar

Srinagar, July 25: Chief Minister, Omar Abdullah has assured the Kashmir-based entrepreneurs that liberal funding would be made available for the rehabilitation of sick units viable for revival. A press handout issued by publicity secretary, Federation Chamber of Industry Kashmir (FCIK) states that a delegation of FCIK had a meeting with Chief Minister Omar Abdullah. Minister for Industries & Commerce Sajad Ahmad Kichloo was also present in the meeting. The FCIK delegation was led by its president Muhammad Ashraf Mir. "The Chief Minister assured the delegation that more funds would be released by the government in the form of soft loans to the potentially viable industrial units in order to rehabilitate them. The Chief Minister also asked the State Financial Corporation to consider one-time settlement scheme

for providing a window to the borrowers unable to meet the huge interest liabilities accumulated during the period of turmoil," the statement reads. It said that FCIK brought to the notice of chief minister the non-availability of industrial land. "The chief Minister instructed the SIDCO management to cancel all the land allotments wherein the units have not been established within the specified time. The orders for cancellation of land allotment to SAIL at Lasipora were issued on the spot as the SAIL has failed to establish the steel plant at Lasipora," the statement said. The statement adds that on the demand of the FCIK the Chief Minister agreed that more incentives would be provided for establishment of industry in far flung areas. For this Principal Secretary Industries & Commerce Khurshid Ahmad Ganai was asked to prepare a policy to be adopted.

## Serious faults hit 2 Air India Boeing 787 Dreamliners

New Delhi, July 25: Air India suffered a double whammy once again when two of its Dreamliners reported serious faults just before take off from here for Birmingham and Sydney and had to be grounded, airline sources said today. The two Boeing 787s, which were to take off for their destinations just 10 minutes apart yesterday, had to be replaced with new planes which flew the passengers to their respective destinations, they said. Last week too, two of the airline's Dreamliners, one set to launch its Moscow operations and the other to Singapore, had suffered technical problems almost simultaneously. Yesterday afternoon, the Dreamliner, operating flight

AI-302 to Sydney with 246 people on board, was grounded after a suspected snag in the engine. Another aircraft was arranged for the stranded passengers and the flight, slated at 1325 hours, left three hours later. Another Boeing 787, operating AI-113 to Birmingham with 126 passengers on board, experienced trouble when it was taxiing for take-off as the crew found that one of the doors had not shut properly. The aircraft returned to the bay and efforts by engineers to shut the door failed, forcing replacement of the airplane, the sources said, adding that the passengers were deplaned and another aircraft was deployed to fly them. The flight, scheduled to depart at 1335 hours, was delayed by 90 minutes.
