

Sagar stresses officers to ensure smooth Eid festivities

Srinagar, July 26: The Minister for Rural Development and Panchayats, Ali Muhammad Sagar has stressed officers of different departments to work in a co-ordinated manner and synergize their efforts to ensure that people do not face any inconvenience in view of the ensuing Eid festivities.

Addressing a high level meeting of officers of different departments to discuss the arrangements on the eve of Eid-ul-Fitr, Sagar asked the Divisional Administration to ensure that people get the basic amenities, besides making available essentials including rice, sugar, atta, K-oil and LPG cylinders in the valley.

The Minister directed the officers of PDD and PHE for ensuring uninterrupted electricity and water supply, besides asking SMC authorities to maintain cleanliness in and around the mosques and shrines including Dargah Hazratbal, Chrar-i-Sharif, Jamia Masjid, Mehboob-ul-Alam, Khankahi Moola and Dastgeer Sahib.

He also directed for installation of street lights and repair of non-functional street lights in the Srinagar city.

Sagar asked the transport authorities to ensure smooth transport system and to provide transport facilities to the people till late hours in the evening.

The Minister also stressed for intensifying market checking to curb black marketing, profiteering and hoarding to make quality items available in adequate quantity to the consumers on Eid festival.

PDP raps crackdown on Srinagar youth

Srinagar, July 26: Slamming the latest crackdown on the youth here, Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) Saturday said it was height of arrogance and insensitivity that people were not even being allowed to live in peace in the holy month of Ramadhan by the National Conference regime.

"Apparently, on the instructions of ruling party politicians, hundreds of youth across the Srinagar city have been rounded up and locked up on false pretexts, over the last many weeks which has instilled fear and terror amongst the people pushing the situa-

tion to pre-2002 dark era," the party General Secretary, Muhammad Dilwar Mir said in a statement.

Mir said PDP is against any kind of violence, stonelying or disruption of peace, but this government through its wrong policies is adding to the confrontation with the young generation.

"On one hand NC is resorting to repression and on the other jobs are being sold in open market, backdoor has been now made regular mode of employment and credibility of the institutions has been grossly compromised. This government has adopted an anti-youth policy," he said.
