

Govt eases restrictions on issuing of NOC for ex-militants

Srinagar, Aug 1: The State government has eased restrictions on issuing of no objection certificates for obtaining passport for persons who have given up militancy for more than 15 years.

"Keeping in view the overall improvement in the security scenario in the state, representations received from the general public and political representatives, the state government has decided to further liberalise the policy for issuance of verification for obtaining passports," an official spokesman said today.

The amended policy provides for issuance of clearance for obtaining passport for Haj or Umrah in respect of an applicant, who had crossed

over to Pakistan-administered Kashmir (PaK) or Pakistan for obtaining arms training, but has returned and eschewed violence, the spokesman said.

"(The person) is silent, has exhibited a good conduct and completed 15 years or more in the state from the date of his return and on the date of application," he said.

"The amended policy further provides that clearance for issuance of passport will be granted in favour of applicant(s) whose relative(s) have crossed over to PaK or Pakistan, 15 years ago, are silent there and do not have any adverse report from the concerned agencies," he added.

However, there was no

provision for issuing such clearance in respect of an applicant, whose militant relative is still in PaK or Pakistan.

Further, there was no explicit provision to deal with the cases of such youth who had returned home from PaK or Pakistan.

Under the directions of Chief Minister Omar Abdullah, the state government had in 2011 simplified the guidelines relating to the issuance of verification for obtaining passports.

These guidelines provide for issuance of verification for passport purposes to the relatives of militants who have died 10 years back or have surrendered 12 years ago. *PTI*

Hari Pora cries PDD's discrimination, seeks probe

Ganderbal, Aug 1: The residents of Hari Pora Manigam here have accused the Power Development Department (PDD) of resorting to discrimination in power distribution from the Kangan Chinnar Receiving Station.

The residents said the Receiving Station feeds the area through three separate feeders for Hari Pora, Chattergul and Prang. They said while Chattergul and Prang are given adequate power supply, Hari Pora was being given least power share.

"This is because some of the Receiving Station staffers hail from the two areas," the residents said.

They said many times they approached the Receiving Station authorities to verify why Hari Pora was often reeling under darkness. "We were told that the problem was with the maintenance of the lines feeding Hari Pora. But how can power supply remain affected for months together and why such a problem with Hari Pora alone," the residents argued.

They appealed PDD Chief Engineer, Bashir Ahmed Khan to look into the matter. When contacted the Chief Engineer said the matter would be looked into.

Pulwama-Sangam Road: Stakeholders complain of defective upgradation

Pulwama, Aug 1: Expressing dissatisfaction over the imperfect upgradation of Pulwama-Tahab-Niana-Sangam road, the residents of the area have complained that the ongoing road widening is not being done as per norms and standard operating procedure as many patches are being left unattended. They also complained of inferior quality of macadamisation work which will not last long.

The stakeholders said that

Pulwama-Tahab-Niana-Sangam road is a vital link leading not only to the Valley's largest industrial estate at Lassipora, but also acts as an alternate link to the Srinagar-Jammu highway.

The stakeholders including unit holders at SIDCO Complex Lassipora have demanded four-laning of Pulwama-Tahab-Niana-Sangam road given its economic importance. They said the road could be taken

up for four-laning under Central Road Fund (CRF). Seeking intervention of the R&B Minister, Divisional Commissioner Kashmir and District Development Commissioner Pulwama into the matter, the locals have demanded strict monitoring of the ongoing upgradation work especially on the stretch from Pulwama to Lassipora via Tahab so that there is no compromise on the quality of the work. *GKNN*

Tosamaidan sanitisation TBF, JKRTIM hail Army initiative

Srinagar, Aug 1: Hailing Army move of sensitizing the Tosamaidan area, J&K RTI Movement (JKRTIM) and Tosamaidan Bachav Front (TBF) Friday said the initiative will save precious lives by detecting and defusing unexploded explosives and artillery shells.

"It is a welcome step and we appreciate it. At the same time we demand the government to constitute Tosamaidan Development authority to supervise promotion of Tosamaidan as a 'Tourism destination,'" TBF chief patron Dr Shiekh Ghulam Rasool said in a statement.

1 drowns in Nilnag lake

Body of ASI retrieved in Baramulla

Srinagar, Aug 1: One person drowned in Nilnag lake in Budgam while Police fished out the body of a police officer who drowned in Jhelum in Baramulla.

Mehraj Ahmed Parray son of Muhammad Sultan of Nowpora drowned in Nilnag lake in Chadoora area while taking a bath in it. Police has launched

search to retrieve the body. Meanwhile, police fished out the body of Sanaullah son of Ghulam Hassan of Pehlipora Boniyar near ECO Park, Sheeri. The deceased was an Assistant Sub Inspector of police (Telecommunication) and drowned on July 30 in Jhelum near Khanpora bridge.

Girl injured in mine blast

Baramulla, Aug 1: A 16-year-old girl was injured after she stepped onto a mine in Nambala area of border town in Uri. The girl, Shazia Bano daughter of Mashkoor Ahmad of Nambala Uri was immediately shifted to a Srinagar hospital with severe injuries in her leg.

Police probe woman's death

Srinagar, Aug 1: Police has taken up investigation to ascertain the cause of suspicious death of a woman in Ganderbal.

A 28-year-old lady Sakeena Begum wife of Hilal Ahmad Kalwal was brought to Sub District Hospital, Ganderbal by her brother and relatives from Checki Fatehpura, where doctors declared her brought dead, police said. Police has taken up the investigation to ascertain the cause of her suspicious death.

Cloud burst in Awantipora Police evacuates 4 families

Srinagar, Aug 1: Police shifted four families to safety in Pampore area after a cloud burst hit Gundbal village which damaged a Masjid and some houses.

According to reports, at about 10 p.m. last night, a Masjid, some houses and a cow shed were partially damaged when a cloud burst hit Gundbal village. However, no loss of life was reported in the incident.


Meanwhile, police evacuated four families to safer place as a precautionary measure.

As per the guidelines of National Project for Cattle and Buffalo Breeding under activity Component "Establishment of Private Artificial Insemination workers" and in order to promote Private Mobile Artificial Insemination services for door step delivery of Artificial Insemination and to give boost to the development of livestock sector, applications are invited from unemployed local youth especially from far-flung areas / so far uncovered areas with regard to Artificial Insemination of Kashmir Division including Leh and Kargil Districts for undergoing short term training course (four months; one month classwork and three months field training) in Artificial Insemination as Private Artificial Insemination Worker. The Private Artificial Insemination workers after receipt of training shall be provided Artificial Insemination inputs and other items that may be required for providing door to door service to the breeders. However, the cost of semen straws, sheaths, gloves, and liquid nitrogen shall be recovered from the Private Artificial Insemination worker on no profit no loss basis. The application as per the enclosed format should reach the office of the undersigned at Livestock Development Board Kashmir office at Shalteng, opposite Unani Hospital, Bye-pass Srinagar by or before 3 P.M. on 14-08-2014.

- TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**
- The selection and training of Private Artificial Insemination worker shall in no case entitle the candidate to get absorbed in the Department of Animal Husbandry/ Livestock Development Board.
 - In case the Private Artificial Insemination worker gets private/Govt. Job he shall have to return the Artificial insemination inputs received from LDB Kashmir including the cryocan and allied equipment.
 - Selected Artificial Insemination worker will be paid a stipend of Rs. 1500/- per month during the training period and a tapering grant of Rs. 6000/- (one time assistance) in the form of semen straws, liquid nitrogen etc.
 - The Private Artificial Insemination worker shall charge a minimum of Rs.50/- per Artificial Insemination and a maximum of Rs.100/- per AI keeping in view the distance covered by the Private Artificial Insemination Worker to provide the Artificial Insemination service.
 - The Artificial Insemination worker has to execute a memorandum of understanding / agreement to ensure that the investments made in training and equipment does not go waste and recoveries shall be made from defaulters, if any.
 - The scheme will be monitored by the Chief Animal Husbandry Officers of the concerned district who shall ensure maintenance of proper breeding records and recommend further retraining of the worker if the skills attained are not adequate.
 - Only the local youth with minimum qualification of Matric and maximum of 10+2 shall be selected as they know the area and utility of timely service.
 - Minimum age of the Artificial Insemination worker shall be 18 years. 9. The Private Artificial Insemination Worker shall have to abide by all other terms and conditions as envisaged in the scheme.
